For the past 20 years, our cumulative **PhD matriculation rate is** in excess of 80% with trainees going to schools like Brown, Cornell, Duke, Rochester, UAB, UCLA, UNC, UVA, the University of Chicago, Wake Forest, Yale, to pursue their PhDs.
